The 10th Graduation Ceremony of Military Institute of Science and Technology (MIST) was held on 06 March 2012 at Mirpur Cantonment, Dhaka. Hon'ble Minister, Ministry of Education, Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid, MP graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Commandant MIST, Major General Hameed-Al-Hasan, ndc (presently on leave preparatory to retirement) presided over the ceremony.

Honorable Education Minister handed over B.Sc Engineering Certificates to a total of 209 students. Among them 55 students were from Civil Engineering Department (CE), 55 students from Computer Science and Engineering Department (CSE), 56 students from Electrical, Electronic and Communication Engineering Department (EECE) and 43 students from Mechanical Engineering Department (ME). Rahnuma Rifat Chowdhury, EECE Department was awarded with the highest academic award of 'Osmany Memorial Gold Medal' for her outstanding result. She attained CGPA 3.98 in scale of 4.00.

Chief of three Services, Parliament Members, High Commissioners, Ambassadors, Secretaries of different Ministries, Vice Chancellors of different Universities, high civil and military officials and academicians were also present in the ceremony.
